## Key Duties & Responsibilities:

- Supporting Learners to complete Construction NVQs Level 4-7, primarily Construction Supervision & Management qualifications.
- Undertake pre-assessments to gather information on learners' existing skills and knowledge.
- Plan and deliver effective assessments to measure learners' competence against occupational standards.
- Assess learners' competence in construction-related tasks through observation, questioning, and professional discussions.
- Provide guidance, support, and coaching to learners to help them achieve NVQ qualifications within the expected timescales.
- Maintain accurate and up-to-date learner records, documenting progress, and assessment outcomes on the ePortfolio.
- Liaise with employers, and 3B staff to ensure effective communication and coordination.
- Keep up to date with industry changes, regulatory requirements, and best assessment practices.
- Maintain high quality standards and implement improvements as identified by internal and external quality assurers.
- Attend client meetings with the NVQ and Sales teams as required.
